Strengths

1.01 takes a nursing history

She also has a clear understanding of how the information can be used to develop a care plan for the patient. Kristina has completed numerous admission and floors.

Kristina has worked with her peers to develop a learning plan to teach staff and patients the proper techniques to use when dealing with a patient with a cervical fracture. They researched the different types of C fractures, caring for a patient pre and post op and the use of traction and the halo.
